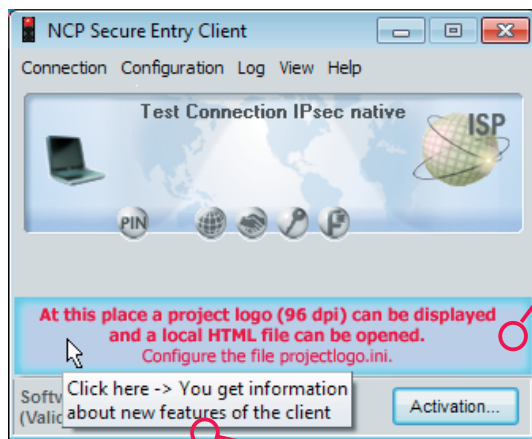


Company or Project Logos integrated into the GUI

By default, the Entry Client is provided with an additional information field - the banner (illustration to the left). Clicking on the banner opens a local HTML page.



The banner can be replaced by your company logo and the local HTML file by one of your choice. Both files are stored in the installation directory of the Entry Client under \ProjectLogo as Logo_en.bmp and secure_entry_banner_en.html. Additionally a tool tip can be shown when the mouse pointer touches the banner or the logo.

Exchange company logo and HTML file

The file projectlogo.ini, which is also to be found in the installation directory, describes how a banner is imported. You can make the following entries:

```
[GENERAL]
Picture_96 = Logo
Picture_120 = Logo
ToolTip1 = Text line
HtmlLocal = local HTML file
```

Logo.bmp

Your logo is displayed over the full width of the monitor. The logo has to be available as bitmap (with 96 or 120 dpi); 96 dpi for displays with small fonts and 120 dpi for displays with large fonts. The size of the bitmap is given. Small fonts: A minimum of 24 pixels for its height and exactly 328 pixels for its width. Large fonts: A minimum of 29 pixels for its height and exactly 404 pixels for its width. The bitmap can be stored in any local directory. If it is stored in the installation directory, the path does not have to be added to the name in the INI file. If not, the name of the bitmap has to be added including the path.

Text Line for Tool Tip

Text lines for tool tips have to be numbered consecutively per line, starting with ToolTip[1] to ToolTip[n]. For example:

```
ToolTip1 = Click here -> You get information
ToolTip2 = about new features of the client
```

Local HTML File

The HTML file, which is to be shown with a click on the project logo, has to be available in a local directory on the PC. If no path is entered, a file from the installation directory of the client is used. For example: HtmlLocal = Whatsnew.html

Switch off Banner

The NCP banner automatically disappears after licensing of the software. If it is to be switched off earlier, simply rename the file ProjectLogo.ini - for example ProjectLogo.in_.
