The dynamic firewall allows Viigo to set policies for ports, IP addresses and segments, as well as applications. The Friendly Net Detection, created by NCP engineering, forces the network to identify itself to the device, preventing any data packet transfer until a safe network has been detected. Configuration and policy logic are easily set and managed centrally or through the NCP Secure Entry Client itself.

"NCP engineering is the only universal VPN client provider we could find that offered both XP 64-bit and Vista compatibility while not forcing vendor lock on us," said Reza Vaziri, IT manager, Viigo. "Like most companies today, we have a mixed OS environment and having our security policies influenced by the deficiencies of a client software is not an option for us. The efficiency of our remote staff and the security of our network can now be maximized."
